Rev. Marilyn F. Chivington Hardman, 87, who died on May 5. Marilyn was preceded in death by her first husband, Rev. Claude E. Chivington, granddaughter, Carrie Roeth, and her twin brother, Rev Marion Hanover. Surviving are their three children, Maribelle (Rev. Daniel) Bare, Claudia (Rev. Gary) Rode and Rev. David (Roxy) Chivington. All six pastors serve or served in the West Ohio Conference. Her second husband, Wayne E. Hardman, also preceded her in death. This union gave her two stepchildren, Candy (Tony) Hoekstra and Marty Hardman.
