Distribution of Funds

Contributions can be directed to Iowa State University's Construction Engineering Scholarship Fund, to the Construction Management Scholarship Fund at the University of Northern Iowa or to both. Contributors can allocate funds in any combination of their choosing.

For example, a contribution can be split in a number of ways:

1. 100% to the institution of your choice.
2. 50% to ISU and 50% to UNI.
3. 70% to UNI and 30% to ISU.

Contributions will be MATCHED on a dollar for dollar basis by the Master Builders of Iowa! The matched funds provided by MBI will then be distributed at the discretion of the MBI Scholarship & Academic Advisory Committee.
