Assessment for Responsive Teaching (ART) is a state-funded project at the Collaborative for Educational Services. We provide **free, ongoing follow-up support (technical assistance)** for all educators and administrators trained in GOLD™. Our aim is to help educators learn how to make formative assessment and the use of GOLD™ a more manageable, meaningful, integrated part of classroom practice.
