Dress Code Reminder

Starting May 1st, navy blue shorts may be worn with a solid white shirt-no logo on the shirt. For the girls, socks should be white or navy knee socks or white or navy tights.

Protecting God's Children

If you are not already eligible, it is not too early to begin to prepare to be a room parent or classroom volunteer for next year. All school volunteers are required to complete the Protecting God's Children awareness session prior to the first day of volunteering. You can only register for the class online https://www.virtus.org/virtus/protecting-children.cfm

Sessions are currently being offered at some of the Catholic churches in the area. If you take the class at another parish you simply need to provide a copy of your certificate to our PGC/Safe Environment Coordinator. All volunteers also need to be finger-printed. Persons living in Ohio for less than five years need to have an FBI check.
