CSA, or community supported agriculture, is a partnership of mutual commitment between a farm and a community of supporters – CSA members make a commitment to support the farm throughout the season, assuming the risks and bounty of growing food along with the farmer. The farm provides, to the best of its ability, a healthy supply of seasonal fresh produce throughout the growing season. CSA promotes a responsible relationship between people and the food they eat, the land on which it is grown, and those who grow it.

Your Share

We grow a wide variety of vegetables and herbs on the farm using organic methods and pack you a box of tasty, fresh farm food each week. Your box will include favorites such as lettuce, tomatoes, potatoes, cukes, broccoli, onions and carrots as well as a few less common vegetables for seasonal variety like brussel sprouts, kale and eggplant. You are always welcome to visit the farm and harvest pick your own crops as available during the season.

Share sizes:

- * Standard share: 8-12 items per week plus pick-your-own crops, sized for a small household
- * Small share: 4-5 items per week plus pick-your-own crops, sized for a single person

Share Lengths:

- * Full season shares start the first week in June and end the last week in October
- * Summer shares start the first week in June and end the last week in August.
- * Fall shares start the first week in September and end the last week in October
