# Common Thread CSA 2015 Agreement Form On farm pick up

**CSA,** or Community Supported Agriculture, is a partnership of mutual commitment between a farm and a community of supporters — CSA members make a commitment to support the farm throughout the season, assuming the risks and bounty of growing food along with the farmer. The farm provides, to the best of its ability, a healthy supply of seasonal fresh produce throughout the growing season.

#### The Share

We grow a wide variety of vegetables, flowers and herbs on the farm using organic methods. Our style of distribution allows you to tailor your share to your own preferences by offering a list of options to choose from each week. Your share also includes pick your own crops such as beans, peas, flowers and herbs that give you a chance to get into the fields each week and further tailor your share to your preferences.

### Pick up times and farm staff hours

You may pick up your share at the barn on the farm on Tuesdays between 2 and 7 pm or on Saturday between 9 am and 1 pm. Farm staff will be on hand to assist and answer questions the entire time for the first week of distribution, and after that, from 3-6 pm on Tuesdays and from 9 am-noon on Saturdays. Pick your own will be open every day during daylight hours.

#### Share sizes:

- \* **Standard share:** 8 items per week plus pick-your-own crops, sized for a small household
- \* Mini share: 4 items per week plus pick-your-own crops, sized for a single person
- \* Large share: 11 items per week plus pyo crops, sized for a large or vegetable-loving household

## **Share lengths:**

- \* **Full season shares** start the first week in June and end the last week in October
- \* **Summer shares** start the first week in June and end the last week in August
- \* **Fall shares** start the first week in September through the last week in October.

### Payment plans and sponsored shares:

We are able to set up payment plans upon request. We also offer a limited number of subsidized CSA shares for families who cannot afford the full price. Please contact us if you are interested in a sponsored share.
