

2016 PCSC SERVICE RIFLE MATCH SCHEDULE



GENERAL RULES FOR 2016



NOTE: 2016 PCSC SERVICE RIFLE MATCHES ARE HELD ON THE SECOND OR THIRD SATURDAY OF THE MONTH EXCEPT DECEMBER

All Non-Members and Guests must complete and sign a PCSC 'RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT' prior to each competition, per PCSC club rules.

No competitor may win more than one certificate in a Class or Division in each Match.

During the 2016 PCSC Service Rifle Match schedule, up to five 'sighter' shots will be allowed in certain matches. The 'sighter' shots must be used in the first stage of the match.

Example: the first stage of shooting requires 10 shots of a total of 30 shots in the match for score. Up to 5 sighter shots may be fired in the first stage (for a total of 15 shots), so the target could potentially have 35 bullet holes at the end of the match. The target would be scored by counting the highest 30 scoring shots. The 'sighter' shots are not required nor must the contestant shoot all 5 'sighter' shots. If the contestant shoots less than five 'sighter' shots the best 30 shots (as in the example) would be counted.

The designated PCSC MATCH RANGE is CLOSED to all other shooting during each event

NOTE: NO 'LICENSED to CARRY' HANDGUNS ARE PERMITTED

FOR ANY 'COMPETITORS' DURING A PCSC SERVICE RIFLE MATCH

Division I – Unaltered general issue service rifle from any country used up to and including the Korean War (approximately 1900-1953).

Division II – Unaltered general issue service rifle (or civilian equivalent) from any country used after the Korean War (1954-present).

NOTE: ADDITIONAL DIVISIONS MAY BE ADDED FOR EACH SPECIFIC COMPETITION

All PCSC competitions will have 'match specific' safety rules which will also be explained in the pre-match safety briefing. All competitors are required to attend the pre-match safety briefing. Safety violations by any competitor may result in disqualification.

Slings – The use of a rifle sling is authorized except when shooting in the standing, 'off-hand' position. When shooting 'off-hand', the sling must be removed or pulled up tight in the 'parade position' on the rifle.

Entry fee for each Service Rifle Match is based on the match type and is listed after each match description. All shooting will be with 'open' or manual 'iron sights' unless otherwise noted in the match description.

In 2016, the PCSC will host three sanctioned (3) Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) competitions. Information specific to the CMP competition rules is available at www.odcmp.com/

JANUARY

#1 Saturday, January 16, 2016

100yd 3 position (35 RD) MATCH

PCSC VINTAGE SERVICE RIFLE 'THREE POSITION' MATCH.

'...bust out those 'Old Soldiers' and M1 Carbine 'War Babies'...!

DIVISION I – M1 GARAND

DIVISION II – M1903/ 1903A3, U.S. BOLT

DIVISION III – FOREIGN BOLT

DIVISION IV – M1 CARBINE



A 100 yards match shot in three relays, first (1st) relay up to 15 rounds timed slow fire, 5 'sighters' and 10 shots, prone position for score, single load/ single fire (15 minutes PRONE position only); second (2nd) relay 10 rounds rapid fire (80 seconds PRONE position only). Third (3rd) relay, shot 'off hand' single load/ single fire, (slings removed or in 'Parade Position') 10 rounds timed slow fire (10 minutes). Note: the M1 Carbine only may fire from a loaded magazine in the 'slow prone' and 'off hand' stages.

ALL RIFLES will be shot using 'as issued' OPEN SIGHTS. Rifles will be fired the 'B' Range using the SR-1 target.

Certificates will be presented for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place per DIVISION.

Five 'sighter' shots are allowed on the first stage only.

Entry fee \$10 per first rifle entered; \$5 for each additional rifle.

FEBRUARY

#2 Saturday, February 20, 2016

AS-ISSUED MILITARY SERVICE RIFLE 200 YARD 'THREE POSITION' MATCH.

DIVISION I – VINTAGE (1900-1953)

DIVISION II – MODERN (1954 – PRESENT)



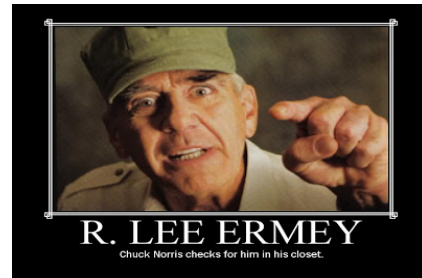
Starting at 10 AM; registration begins at 9 AM. A 200 yards match shot in three relays, first (1st) relay up to 15 rounds timed slow fire, 5 'sighters' and 10 shots for score, single load/ single fire (15 minutes PRONE position only) and second (2nd) relay 10 rounds rapid fire (80 seconds PRONE position only). Third (3rd) relay, shot OFF HAND (slings removed or in 'Parade Position'), 10 rounds timed slow fire (10 minutes). Open to Division I Vintage (1900 to 1953) and Division II Modern (1954 to present) rifles, fired on the 'C' Range using the SR-C target.

Five 'sighter' shots will be allowed on first stage only.

Certificates will be presented for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in Division I and Division II.

Entry fee \$10 for first rifle entered; \$5 for each additional rifle.

Saturday, March 19, 2016 'URBAN RIFLE' MATCH

...as 'GUNNY' R. Lee Ermey says, 'TOUGH UP SISSY BOYS'...!

Yes...you'll have to toss that 'grenade' again!

NOTE EARLIER MATCH START TIME! Registration begins at 8AM, safety meeting at 8:50AM, MATCH BEGINS at 9 AM.

This is a long, tough, and exhausting competition...be prepared to assist as Range Safety Officers and Match Timers. Fifty rapid fire shots from three different barriers shot 20, 10, and 20 rounds. A 'shoot and move with verified empty rifles' match where accuracy and speed are scored.

Rifles are shot left and right hand (total of 50 rounds) from barriers including prone; each under the pressure of being timed. Competitors will then move to a short range and shoot a handgun (right and left hand; 5 rounds each hand, with magazine reload) and finally, load and fire one round from a pump shotgun, busting a 'skeet' to stop the clock. A replica hand grenade is tossed to 'start the clock', providing additional scoring points based of accuracy of toss.

FOUR DIVISIONS:

DIVISION I - Detachable magazine rifles shot with open sights 5 MINUTES

DIVISION II - Detachable magazine rifles shot with optic sights 5 MINUTES

DIVISION III - M1 Garand 6 MINUTES

DIVISION IV - Bolt action rifles 8 MINUTES

All firing will be on the "B" Range using the B27E target.

Certificates presented for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each of the four classes.

Entry fee \$10 for first rifle entered; \$5 for each additional rifle.

All rifles fired on the 'C' Range, B27E target.

Open to Division I VINTAGE and Division II MODERN rifles.

Certificates provided for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place each Division.

Match starting at 10 AM; registration beginning at 9 AM, fired on the 'C' Range using the SR-C target center. A 200 yards match shot in three relays, first (1st) relay up to 15 rounds timed slow fire, 5 'sighters' and 10 shots for score, single load/ single fire (15 minutes PRONE position only) and second (2nd) relay 10 rounds rapid fire (80 seconds PRONE position only). Third (3rd) relay, shot OFF HAND, single load/ single fire (slings removed or in 'Parade Position'), 10 rounds timed slow fire (10 minutes).Thirty five (35) rounds fired (30 for score).

Certificates will be awarded for the top three competitors in:

LEVER RIFLE 100yd 3 POSITION (35 RD) MATCH



Match starting at 10 AM, registration beginning at 9 AM. Three Position 100 yard Match fired on the "B" Range using the SR-1 target. Thirty five (35) rounds fired (30 for score). Shot in three relays, first (1st) relay up to 15 rounds timed slow fire, 5 sighters* and 10 shots for score (15 minutes PRONE position only) and second (2nd) relay 10 rounds rapid fire (80 seconds PRONE position only). Third (3rd) relay is shot 'OFF HAND' using no slings. Ten (10) rounds timed slow fire (10 minutes).

Open to ALL MAKES and MODELS of 'VINTAGE STYLE' LEVER and TRAP DOOR RIFLES, original or replica models, UP TO .44 MAGNUM and .45-120 CALIBER.

Certificates provided for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each of the three divisions.

Five 'sighter' shots are allowed on the first stage only.

Match starting at 10 AM, registration beginning at 9 AM.

Three-Position Match designed for AR-15 (.223/5.56) and AR-10 (.308/7.62x51, 7.62x39) RIFLES. (NOTE: FN SCAR .223 and .308 rifles, HK-91 and HK-93, FN FAL (L1A1) .308/7.62x51 rifles, SKS, and AK-47 7.62x39 rifles are allowed).

Rifles will be fired on the "C" Range using the SR-C target center. Thirty five rounds (35), thirty (30) for score, shot at 200 yards in three relays, first relay up to 15 rounds timed slow fire, 5 'sighter' shots and 10 shots for score, single load/ single fire (15 minutes in the prone position); second relay 10 rounds rapid fire (80 seconds in the prone position); third relay 10 rounds timed slow fire, single load/ single fire (10 minutes in the off-hand position).

TWO MATCH EVENT - MATCH 'A'

THE 'SIXTH ANNUAL' PCSC VINTAGE SNIPER TWO-MAN TEAM COMPETITION



Match 'A' beginning at 10 AM, registration beginning at 9 AM; shot on Range 'C' with the reduced yardage 'MR-52' targets. The PCSC Two-Man Sniper Team match is a 'Modified CMP' style competition.

**NOTE: 1. NON-GUNSMITHING 'NO-DRILL' SCOPE MOUNTS ARE ALLOWED IN THIS EVENT
2. EARLY DESIGN 3X9 VARIABLE SCOPES WITH CROSS-HAIRS OR GERMAN 'POST' RETICLES ARE PERMITTED (no modern reticles allowed). NOTE, THE POWER SETTING MUST BE SET AT THE MAXIMUM ALLOWED FOR THE RIFLE PER CMP RULES, AND NOT MODIFIED DURING THE MATCH...'HONOR SYSTEM' APPLIES...!**

SPECIAL NOTE: ONLY GERMAN WWII ZF-41 'SCOUT-SCOPE' OPTICS ALLOWED.



Twenty (20) rounds fired in 15 minutes by each shooter; single 'MR-52' REDUCED YARDAGE '600/200' SLOW FIRE TARGET shot at 200 yards on the 'C' RANGE.

Each TWO-MAN TEAM MEMBER's individual target will be scored; then both individual targets will be added together and divided by two to create the final TWO-MAN SNIPER TEAM SCORE. Certificates will be presented for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place SNIPER TEAMS.

Entry fee \$10 for first rifle entered; \$5 for each additional rifle.

MATCH 'B' – OPEN CLASS LONG RANGE SNIPER MATCH



This is an "OPEN CLASS" competition for individuals who wish to compete with any center fire rifle under .50 BMG caliber, any optic, any bipod, or sand/ range bags.

Snipers will shoot ten (10) rounds fired in the 'prone' in 10 minutes. Single load or shot from mag. The SR-1 target will be shot at 250 yards.

NOTE: NO 'BENCH REST' SHOOTING or 'SIGHTER SHOTS' ALLOWED IN THE 'OPEN SNIPER' RIFLE COMPETITION.

Certificates will be presented for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place.

Entry fee \$10 for first rifle entered; \$5 for each additional rifle.
