ACT PREPARATION

Today's student is finding the college admission and scholarship process highly competitive. One of the most important factors in his or her career could be acceptance into the university of his or her choice. Colleges primarily use the scores from the American College Testing Program (ACT) to select applicants and award scholarships. We strongly suggest students register for and take the April 9th ACT.

The Lake Park ACT preparatory course for high school students is designed to develop the skills to improve ACT scores. In addition to English, science, reading and mathematics preparation, the course emphasizes test-taking strategies and techniques as well as using retired tests to continually measure progress and mastery of skills. Students will gain exposure to ACT testing situations, practice and remediation, and explanations on ACT style correct questions and types of answers meant to distract from the correct response.

We offer two different opportunities to better meet our students' needs. The first choice is an 8 session course offered on Saturday mornings. The other choice is an 18 session course offered on Tuesdays and Thursdays after school. These programs are designed the same way, just providing 2 different time periods to better meet students' needs. Once one choice is selected, that choice will remain throughout the course; you can attend a make-up or switch a session only 1 time per year. The registration cost before December 18th is \$190 and after December 18th is \$210. Registration deadline is Monday, January 4, 2016.
