Locate the correct ISBN number, which is on the back of the book, near the barcode. Use the ISBN when purchasing books online or from a bookstore.

For your convenience a book fair will be held on-campus for students from August 31 - September 11. Additionally, the book fair will be open in the library during the East Campus Curriculum Night. Books can be purchased at the school library using cash, credit card, or with a check written to Lake Park High School.
