  2. **Schedule:** Depart at 7:55am on March 8, 2016 from John Wayne airport and return the same evening around 8:20pm. Student must be available all day to attend the trip.
  3. **Required Meetings Prior to the Trip:**
    - One 30 minute individual school meeting week of 1/26 before school or lunch
    - Five evening meetings at the high school campuses: Monday 2/1 and 2/8, Tuesday 2/16, Monday 2/22 and 2/29 from 6:30-8pm
    - One follow up meeting after trip: TBD
  4. **Registration Fee:** Northwood High School PTSA will cover fees which include round trip airfare, ground transportation in Sacramento and lunch. (Transportation to and from John Wayne airport and dinner at the Sacramento airport will be on your own.)

Please respond thoughtfully. Your answers should be typed on a separate paper and attached to this form. A personal interview might be required.
