## **Recap 2015-16 Activities**

The PSO held two major events, the Mile Run (led by Mark and Hillary Ross, in coordination with GHNO) and the Spring Carnival (chaired by Cori Kyle and co-chaired by Cassi Diaz). The PSO also coordinated smaller, community-building events like meetups at playgrounds and trampoline parks. At the Lower School, through volunteer coordinator Dawn Greer, the room parents assisted the teachers and hosted events such as end-of-quarter parties that tied in with the curriculum. Barbara Tavares managed the collection and sale of used uniforms, which raised money for the PSO and saved families money on buying uniforms. Kim Scott managed the production of a new batch of spirit wear, which raises money for the PSO and also provides students with T-shirts to wear on spirit days. Jennifer Osborn worked with the students who prepared the yearbook and helped market the yearbooks to families. The Helping Hands committee, led by Tiffany Hartnett at the Lower School and Neesha Grubbs at the Upper School, planned meal calendars for faculty who welcomed new babies, and coordinated gifts, meals, and decorations for Teacher Appreciation Week. Volunteers helped stock the teachers' lounges, led by Nancy Sheridan at the Lower School and Neesha Grubbs. Upper School volunteers helped with meals and refreshments at events, including the symposium and the sports banquet. Diana Chase scheduled several Coffee with the Headmaster meetings to promote dialogue between parents and school leaders. Volunteers participated in a park cleanup at San Pedro Springs Park. Gail Carrasco collected Box Tops to raise money.

## Treasurer's Report

The PSO's bylaws provide that, at the end of the year (end of May/beginning of June), 80 percent of the funds in the PSO's bank account will be swept into a general Great Hearts Texas account. So, every year the PSO strives to raise funds and then spend them before the end of the year.

In 2015-16, the Mile Run raised funds for athletics. It was a joint event with Great Hearts Northern Oaks. The funds from the Mile Run, plus additional PSO money, was used to purchase strength conditioning equipment for the Upper School, including weights, bars, plates, kettlebells, and mats. Upper School students and faculty are using this equipment regularly. The athletics department will offer a strength conditioning camp this summer. The equipment is portable and can move with the school when it finds a permanent location.

The primary goal of the Second Annual Spring Carnival in May 2016 was to provide a fun event for families and faculty to come together and make memories; fundraising was a secondary goal. Also, the carnival was designed to put less of a burden on the volunteers coordinating it; for example, the length of the carnival was cut from four hours to three hours. As it turned out, the 2016 carnival raised just as much money as the year before, while providing a good time for the hundreds of families who turned out.

Money from the Spring Carnival is being used for several purposes. Part of the money is being used to create an inventory of spirit wear to be sold at 2016-17 events, including Back-to-School Night. (Since the bank account will get cleaned out in June, the PSO need to purchase the inventory now.) Also, the PSO is purchasing shelves and tote boxes to help organize the inventory of used uniforms and spirit wear that is being stored in the PSO closet on the ground floor of the Upper School.

The PSO, in coordination with the Headmasters, is using Spring Carnival money to buy special items for both campuses. At the Upper School, a navy-and-white ping pong table has arrived, and it will have school logo decals. The Upper School will be investing in Loeb Library volumes. At the Lower School, the PSO will purchase additional books for classrooms, plus toys and recess items for the students to play with at recess and during PE classes.

#### **Plans for 2016-17**

As you may be aware, Great Hearts Monte Vista recently changed its leadership structure. Peter Crawford, formerly Headmaster of the entire school, is now Headmaster of the Upper School. Mandi Cannon, formerly Assistant Headmaster of the Lower School, is now Headmaster of the Lower School. In 2016-17, the PSO will function separately at each campus, and may have separate bank accounts as well.
