Carbon Monoxide Safety

For your safety, we require a Combustion Safety Test before and after your Home Upgrade project. This helps keep you safe by detecting carbon monoxide concerns in your home.

- Contractors are trained and use special equipment to detect dangerous carbon monoxide sources
- The testing will show you if any combustion appliances (stove, furnace, water heater, etc.) in your home are unsafe
- Testing will inform you about carbon monoxide concerns during and after your project
