There will also be health screenings for families, the DMV Mobile Unit and the HELP Mobile Unit will be present. Hampton City Schools will also be present to provide information for the parents and students. Workshops will be conducted on Bullying, Violence and other topic areas of interest. Hampton Sheriff's Department will do ID's for kids.

Pastor Gail Roberts-House is coordinating the effort on behalf of the Ministers Alliance subcommittee of the City of Hampton Unity Commission. In speaking with Charles Cheek of HELP, he said: "If we can make this a multi-ethnic/multi-racial event looking like "One Church", I believe Kingdom Building within the City will advance in the eyes of the lost, unsaved and the saved."
