

Donation Guidelines

Accepted Items for Students Ages 4-18

Donations should be clean, in good condition and ready to go home with a student in need.

- ▼ NEW underwear and socks in unopened packages (kids size XS-adult)
- ✓ Footwear (kids size 8T-adult)
- ✓ Warm winter coats and light jackets (kids size XS-adult)
- School uniform clothing (pants, dresses, jumpers or skirts in khaki, black, navy or plaid; solid color polo shirts)
- → Pants and shorts for Girls and Boys (kids size 4T-20)
- ✓ Shirts for Girls and Boys (kids size XS-XL)
- ✓ Adult size clothing that would be worn by teens and pre-teens.
 - o Pants and shorts for Young Women (sizes 00-26) and Young Men (waist sizes 27-48)
 - Shirts for Young Women (sizes XS-3XL) and Young Men (sizes XS-5XL)
- ✓ Dresses and skirts (kids size XS-adult)
- ✔ Bras (all sizes, new and gently used)
- ✓ Accessories, belts, bags/backpacks/purses, pajamas, swimwear, sportswear/equipment, hats, jewelry, books, toys, school supplies and winter accessories.

Top 5 Greatest Needs

Want to hold a drive? Focus on collecting one or more of the items we need most!

- 1. **NEW underwear and socks** (kids size XS-adult)
- 2. **Shoes** that are in good condition and suitable for school. Our most popular styles are athletic shoes (tennis, basketball, running, skate, etc.), slip-ons (*i.e.* Vans), canvas (*i.e.* Converse or Toms) flats, boots (all types) and black uniform shoes. Our most needed sizes are for elementary school age children (kids size 10-size 5 youth).
- 3. Warm winter coats (kids size XS-adult)
- 4. **Jeans and pants!** Girls (4T-18), Boys (4T-20), Young Women (sizes 00-26) and pants/shorts for Young Men (especially waist size 27-36)
- 5. **School uniforms** for elementary/middle school age kids (pants, dresses, jumpers or skirts in khaki, black, navy or plaid; solid color polo shirts)

About Clothes To Kids of Denver

Clothes To Kids of Denver (CTKD) is a 501c3 nonprofit that provides new and quality used clothing to students from low-income or in-crisis families in the Denver Metro Area, free of charge.

Founded in 2008, CTKD has provided thousands of wardrobes to children in preschool through 12th grade. Families are referred to CTKD by schools, school districts, human service agencies, hospitals, clinics, shelters and places of worship or use their Free & Reduced lunch letter as the referral. Students can shop twice a year to get a wardrobe of school clothing: 5 tops, 4 bottoms (pants, shorts or skirts), 1 dress (optional), 5 pairs of new socks, 5 pairs new underwear, 1 pair shoes, 1 coat and extras.
