Clothes To Kids Denver Volunteer Job Descriptions

In the Store

Back Room (Sort, Tag, Hang and Stock Clothing): These ongoing jobs are great for youth and adults and help ensure that we can meet the clothing needs of youth visiting the store.

Shopping Assistant: Help clients select clothing during their visit and help make the shopping experience pleasant and enjoyable. Shopping Assistants are needed from 8:45 am to 12:45 pm Tuesday – Friday, and the 1st Saturday of every month from 9:00 am to 1:30 pm.

Outside the Store

Wash and/or Repair: Spending a little time cleaning and/or repairing donations can save clothes headed for the discard pile. This is an on-going need, and really helps!

Thrift Store Deal Finder/Shopper: Volunteers are needed to shop for new underwear and socks as well as clothing sizes that are missing from our inventory. This is one of our most fun volunteer tasks and training is available for anyone who is interested.

Garage Sale Donation Finder (summer only): CTKD Garage Sale donation finders identify sales that have items appropriate for the clients at CTKD, tell the person holding the sale about the mission of CTKD and return at the end of the sale to pick out items for the store. Only 1-2 sales can fill a car!

Operations

Special Events: Help plan fundraising events or attend networking events on behalf of CTKD. Special Events volunteers serve as an important link between CTKD and the community.

Marketing/PR/Fundraising: Help the Board of Directors get the word out about CTKD by assisting with letter writing, brochure design, newsletter contributions and other special projects. Interested volunteers can work on one or several projects each year, so this is a very flexible commitment.

Donation Pick-up: CTKD is fortunate to have donors all over Denver, and beyond! Volunteers are needed for regular and one-time donation pick-ups. Anyone who signs up for this position will get an email whenever CTKD needs a donation pick-up. All you have to do is respond if you can help, so the time commitment is very flexible.

Board of Directors/Community Advisory Council (CAC): We are always looking for new candidates to join the Board and CAC. Our board members serve two year terms and meet once a month to discuss the organization's goals and overall strategy. Different board positions have different levels of time commitments. We also have a very active CAC that is designed to provide a reservoir of leaders who lend their knowledge to CTKD. CAC members also serve two-year terms and the council usually meets quarterly. If you are interested in either of these groups, a current Board or CAC Member will contact you with additional details.

Special Programs

Apparel Partner Program

Apparel Partner representatives serve as the liaison between CTKD and the retail community and work with the Executive Director to identify and approach companies who may be willing to partner with CTKD. Once retailers are regular donors, Apparel Partner representatives may also be responsible for making reminder calls to businesses and arranging donation pick-ups.

Student Ambassador Program

Youth Role: Student Ambassadors help both their own school and schools in their area plan and carry out clothing drives on behalf of CTKD. This is ideally suited for older students looking for a challenging, on-going volunteer project. Responsibilities of this position may include: 1) contacting elementary, middle and high school student council representatives and/or teachers who may have an interest in conducting a clothing drive, 2) helping students create promotional materials and plan for a drive, 3) supporting students as they carry out drives and 4) coordinating delivery of clothing drive donations to CTKD and 5) recognizing the efforts of the student groups who complete a drive.

<u>Adult Role:</u> CTKD needs adult volunteers who are interested in helping high school age students who choose to become Student Ambassadors. This is a flexible position, and it is perfect for people who can give a little each week.
