

The African-American Chamber of Commerce of PA, NJ & DE (AACC) recently launched The Internship - a 6-week challenge that provide real work experience to college students through weekly competitions, and offers lessons in professional development that students may not receive in the classroom.

A total of six interns (two teams) are chosen for the challenge. Challenges are focused around membership engagement, programming, legislation and professional development.

Cohort III of The Internship starts Monday, July 6, 2015 through August 14, 2015. The selection process to The Internship program is highly competitive. Applicants are encouraged to submit a thorough application that illustrates qualifications, character, and commitment to commerce and membership development. A completed application includes a copy of your resume.

Applicants must be U.S. citizens, 18 years of age on or before the first day of the internship, and meet at least one of the following criteria:

- Currently enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate program at a college, community college, or university (two-to-four year institution)
- Graduated from an undergraduate or graduate program at a college, community college, or university (two-to-four year institution) no more than two years before the first day of the internship.
- Applicants must be able to work 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday Friday.
