The Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA), an agency of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, is the primary Federal agency for improving access to health care by strengthening the health care workforce, building healthy communities and achieving health equity. HRSA's programs provide health care to people who are geographically isolated, economically or medically vulnerable.

As part of HRSA's ongoing commitment to Indian Country's health care needs, this letter serves as official notice of HRSA's intent to hold its annual tribal consultation with tribes. This consultation will be conducted in partnership with the Administration for Children and Families (ACF) on June 15, 2016, from 8:30 AM to 5:15 PM at the Residence Inn Marriot, Capitol Hill, 333 E. HRSA senior leadership will convene the morning consultation session beginning at 8:30 AM on the following priority areas:


- Improving Access to Quality Health Care and Services
