Bilbo Baggins is a comfortably well-off Hobbit with a love for rousing adventure stories. Real adventures, however, are definitely not his cup of tea. But when Gandalf the wizard shows up with a band of wandering dwarves on a mission to recover the lost treasure of Lonely Mountain, he finds himself on a perilous quest encountering Trolls and elves, a battle with Goblins, and a barrel ride in a river. Most importantly this story leads Bilbo into Riddles in the Dark where he meets Gollum and in the process acquires a peculiar ring.
