I (We) hereby elect to waive my (our) right to a formal hearing and voluntarily agree to a Fine of seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500) I (We) agree to pay the Fine by February 29, 2016.

I (We) further understand that the voluntary fine and closure is to be construed as a settlement or disposition related to the current charges pending with the Department of Business Affairs & Consumer Protection under Case Number 15 LR 147. It is further agreed between the parties that the licensee(s) shall not appeal this voluntary fine at any time in the future.

This agreed resolution of the violation(s) is made with express understanding that this voluntary fine and closure shall be made a permanent record of the licensee's disciplinary history and may be introduced as evidence of aggravation in conjunction with other charges of misconduct in any future proceeding.
