 literature. In addition, we offer novels and biographies on political subjects, Democratic
 Headquarters cookbooks with hundreds of favorite recipes from our many supporters, including
 one from Senator Boxer, and, finally, we offer an array of custom-made earrings that are VERY
 Democratic in their custom designs
