The Festival Committee reserves the right to remove any work that differs from submitted photos or work that does not fit with the Festival atmosphere. A price list must be displayed at your booth site at all times during the festival.
- Upon acceptance to the festival be sure to read all vendor information in your vendor packet. You must be checked in by the time stated in your packet or you will not be allowed to set up. You are not allowed to drive through the festival during hours of operation under any circumstance.
- AOP reserves the right to relocate artisans.
- Artisans must stay within the boundaries of their assigned 12' wide X 10' deep booth space(s). Booths will line Main and South Respass streets
- Artisans are responsible for providing **all items** necessary for their booth presentation.
- Fee: AOP Members \$125 - Non-Member \$175
- Pack your umbrellas because the Festival will go on rain or shine!!
