 checked in by the time stated in your packet or you will not be allowed to set up. You are not allowed to drive
 through the festival during hours of operation under any circumstance.
- AOP reserves the right to relocate artisans.
- Artisans must stay within the boundaries of their assigned12' wide X 10' deep booth space(s). Booths will line Main and South Respess streets
- Artisans are responsible for providing all items necessary for their booth presentation.
