






- Applications filings are cases in which the party has filed a motion to reclassify a Proposition 47 eligible felony and is no longer incarcerated or under probation or parole.
- **Petitions** filings are cases in which the party has filed a motion to reduce a Proposition 47 eligible felony and is incarcerated or on probation or parole for that felony.
- Pre-conviction filings are cases in which the party has filed a motion to reduce a Proposition 47 eligible felony to a misdemeanor, prior to being convicted. Source: Superior Court of California, County of Los Angeles





Prop 47 Impacts on LA County Probation and AB109



- ■4.Denied Pro 47 Reduction
- ■5. Reduced and terminated from AB109
- Numbers 1 4 above, represent 6,284 filings; accounting for only 10% of the 60,000 that make up the LA County Probation population.
- **Number 5** represents 1,184 filings; accounting for only 15% of the 8,101 that make up the LA County AB109 population.
