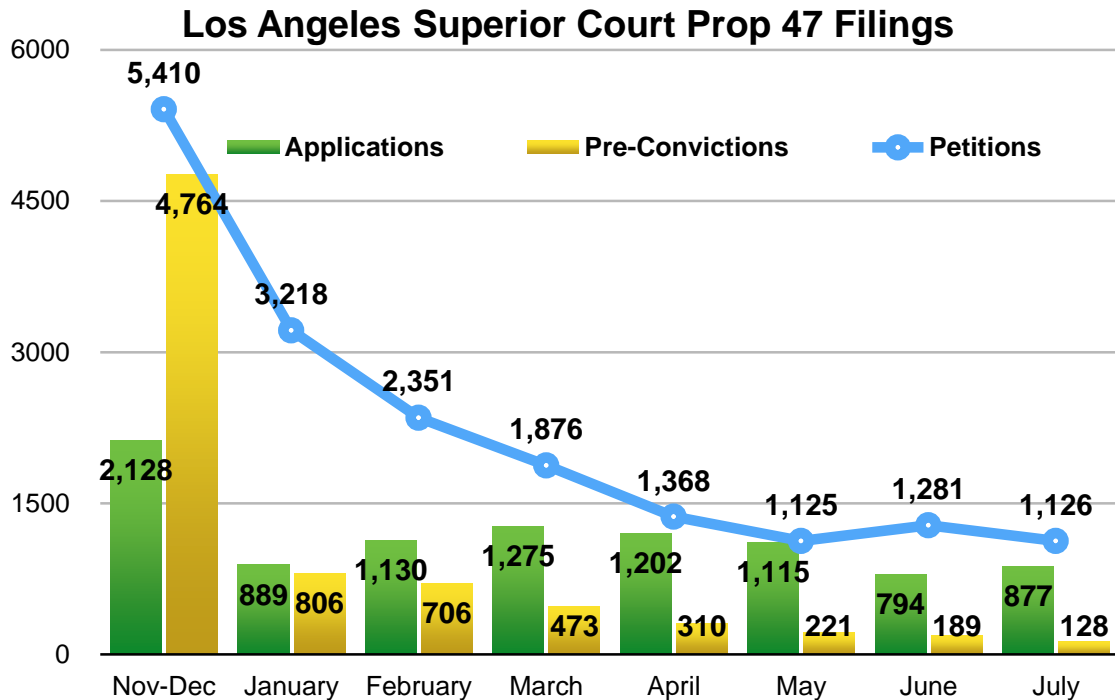


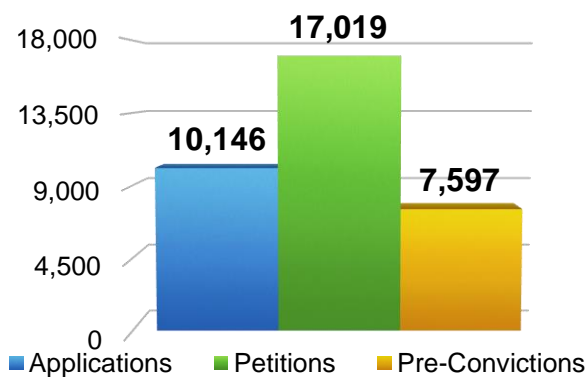
Los Angeles County Prop 47 Progress Report

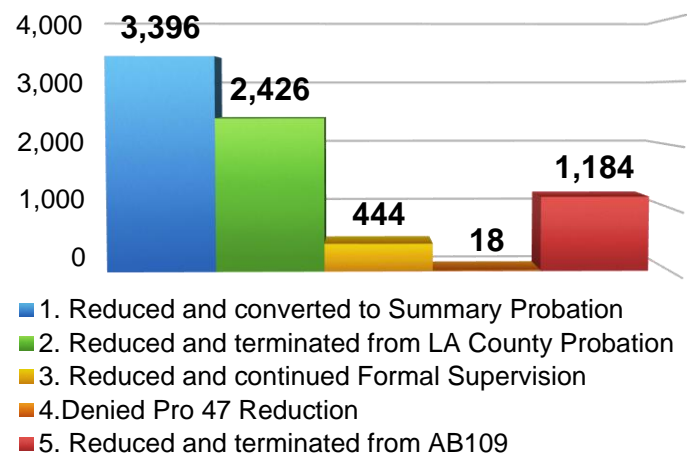


- **Applications** filings are cases in which the party has filed a motion to reclassify a Proposition 47 eligible felony and is no longer incarcerated or under probation or parole.
- **Petitions** filings are cases in which the party has filed a motion to reduce a Proposition 47 eligible felony and is incarcerated or on probation or parole for that felony.
- **Pre-conviction** filings are cases in which the party has filed a motion to reduce a Proposition 47 eligible felony to a misdemeanor, prior to being convicted. **Source:** Superior Court of California, County of Los Angeles

Prop 47 Impacts on LA County Probation and AB109



- **Numbers 1 - 4** above, represent 6,284 filings; accounting for only 10% of the 60,000 that make up the LA County Probation population.
- **Number 5** represents 1,184 filings; accounting for only 15% of the 8,101 that make up the LA County AB109 population.
