Drinking Alcohol in the Past 30 Days - not just a sip or taste!

- 5.6% of 8th graders (14.4/257) report drinking National Norm is 10.2%
- 38.3% of 10th graders (96/251) report drinking National Norm is 25.7%
- 65.6 % of 12th graders (129.2/197) report drinking *National Norm is* 39.2%

Binge Drinking (5 or more alcoholic drinks in a row in the past 2 weeks

- one or more times)
- 2% of 8th graders (5.1/257) report binge drinking National Norm is 5.1%
- 20.5% of 10th graders (51.5/251) report binge drinking National Norm is 13.7%
- 47.4% of 12th graders (93.4/197) report binge drinking National Norm is 22.1%

Teens have easy access & drink in many places



0% of 8th grade students, 9.1% of 10th grade students, and 48% of 12th grade students **bought alcohol themselves from a store**.



51.9% of 8th grade students, 84.3% of 10th grade students, and 85.8% of 12th grade students **got it at a party.**



14.8% of 8th grade students, 56.2% of 10th grade students, and 72.3% of 12th grade students **got it from someone I know under age 21.**



11.1% of 8th grade students, 46.7% of 10th grade students, and 58.6% of 12th grade students drank at an open area like a park, beach or back road.



2.8% of 8th grade students, 19.2% of 10th grade students, and 46.9% of 12th grade students **drank in a car.**
