Romanian Kindergarten Conference in Bucharest

A Romanian Waldorf kindergarten conference took place in Bucharest on April 18/19 at the "Rudolf Steiner House" at Nr. 17 Visinilor Street. Approximately 50 kindergarten teachers participated in the meeting. The themes included "Caring for Relationships Every Day in the Kindergarten and in the Waldorf Kindergarten Movement" (lecture and workshop with Philipp Reubke), handwork (Michaela Angheli), music (Marilena Cazan), and eurythmy (Mriana Marincea).

The conference ended with Romanian folk dances as well as a General Assembly of the "Asociatia Educatoarelor Waldorf din Romania".
