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Punch-in Employment Course

The Punch-in Employment Course is a pilot program presented in an on-line format providing job-seekers with information to start their career search and a social network of mentors, peers, and people to support them in the process. Candidates will be subject to a **mandatory orientation** on **Friday, May 22, 2015**, to confirm eligibility. Currently, the program is limited to 5 participants.

Registrants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Participant will be available June 1 − 12, 2015, and must be able to commit to 16-20 hours
 of course work per week during the two week session.
- 2. Participant must provide their own transportation to and from the training center location.
- 3. Participant must have a primary focus of future employment, but he/she does not have to be actively seeking a job.
- 4. Participant must be academically functioning at a high school level or above with the ability to take and follow instructions.
- 5. Participant must be able to work independently with minimal supervision.
- 4. Participant should be technically savvy and must be proficient with the use of a computer to access email and the internet for course work.
- 5. Participant must have a current and active email and should be comfortable working independently through an on-line learning experience.
- 6. Participant must be proficient in using assistive technology relative to their functional limitation.
- 7. Participant will agree to complete all module assignments and activities within the timeframe required.
- 8. Participant will agree to be honest and kind with their comments on the Punch-in website.
- 9. Participant must agree not to share anything from the Punch-in site (such as comments from other students or copyrighted resources) outside of the closed Punch-in network.
- 10. Participant will agree to evaluate their overall learning experience upon completion of the program.
