- If elected, Recreation NL is calling on your party to endorse a renewal process for Active, Healthy Newfoundland and Labrador and recognize and support the value of recreation by assigning departmental status (either separately or inline with related services) and invest resources to ensure all Newfoundlanders and Labradoreans have access to affordable, equitable and safe recreational pursuits.
- If elected, Recreation NL is calling on your party to increase the allocation of the health care budget spending on health promotion and active living initiatives as an integral part of a health prevention/ primary health care plan.


