Shadow Day Procedures:

- Parents please **drop students off in the Student Parking Lot by 8:00 am**. Shadow Ambassadors will meet their students at the gate that leads from the Student Parking Lot. They will escort them to the auditorium. Any late arriving students should go to the Main Office and an Ambassador will come and pick them up there.
