



## Classroom Highlights

**Theology:** To supplement the experience of Freshman Heritage Day at Villa Maria, Pennsylvania this past September, **Ms. Caitlin Lynch-Huggins '01**, Theology teacher, used 33 scanned photographs of students and faculty during the early years of Magnificat High School. Some of the photographs showed students interacting inside and outside of the classroom with both their fellow students and the nuns, as seen in these examples.

**English:** A DVD of Magnificat High School's theater production of *The Scarlet Letter*, recorded on April 28, 2012, was shown in **Miss Kelly Spencer's** English 11 class. Thirty-six students viewed the video after reading the play so they could "see how a novel is turned into a play," said Miss Spencer.



As an enrichment assignment, the students were told to create a playbill for the Magnificat production, including a product to sell that is based on the characters and plot of the play, with the proceeds benefiting an appropriate charity.
