WHEN IS THE TRIP ???

Sunday, July 17th thru Saturday, July 23rd. Students will need to be at HFN by 6 am Sunday morning and they will need to eat breakfast before they come or bring it with them. We will load our luggage and supplies, have a short group prayer and load up. We will depart for Albuquerque at 6:30 am. The following Saturday we will plan to return to HFN by 6 pm.

WHERE WILL WE BE STAYING ???
