The Alaska Fly Fishers (AFF) represents approximately 350 members residing in all regions of Alaska. AFF works to promote and educate pubic on the sport of fly fishing. AFF also works to preserve fish habitat through conservation projects. One of our largest conservation efforts is the annual Kenai River Cleanup held each September.

AFF wishes to thank the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) for extending the comment period on the above referenced water reservation applications. We have members that fish all the streams in the Chuitna River area which PacRim Coal LLC (PacRim) is proposing to mine coal.

After reviewing the PacRim proposed mining plan, we do not believe the existing interaction between surface and ground water will be able to be achieved or replaced after mining is complete. AFF members that are Fish Biologists Geologists and Engineers support this conclusion. As a result, fish habitat will be impacted. To preserve fish habitat for existing and future uses, AFF strongly recommends DNR approve the water reservation application submitted by the Chuitna Citizens Coalition, Inc.
