E. Robert Levy is Executive Director of, and Counsel to the Mortgage Bankers Association of New Jersey and The New Jersey Association of Mortgage Brokers. He is also Legislative/Regulatory Counsel to the Pennsylvania Association of Mortgage Brokers and the Mortgage Bankers Association of Pennsylvania. Mr. Levy was Deputy Commissioner for the State of New Jersey, Department of Banking And Insurance and was a State Deputy Attorney General. Mr. Levy currently serves on the New Jersey Department of Banking's Residential Mortgage and Consumer Finance Advisory Board. Mr. Levy was instrumental in enacting the first Mortgage Bankers and Brokers License Laws in New Jersey and Pennsylvania, and the mortgage banking regulations in both states. He helped draft and pass the Consumer Equity Protection Act in Pennsylvania and he obtained an amendment to the New Jersey Home Ownership Security Act (NJHOSA) that removed the "reasonable tangible net benefit" provision. Mr. Levy is the Chairman of the Industry Advisory Council to the American Association of Residential Mortgage Regulators (AARMR). He is a Partner in the law firm of Levy & Watkinson, P.C., with offices in Woodbridge, New Jersey.
