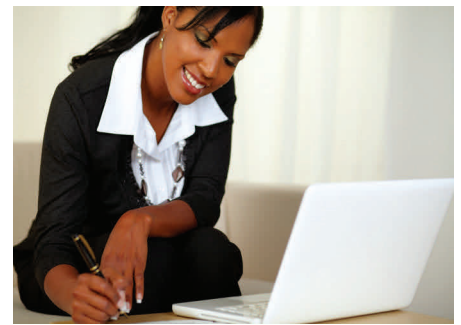
Just in Time Training

You are just a few clicks away from accessing a video library of hundreds of trainings including: Discipline, Toilet Training and How to Integrate a New Child into the Family.

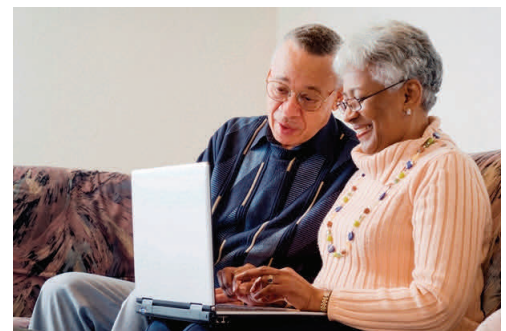
This website has expanded to offer much more. There are community resources, supports, contact information and QPI workgroup information.
