blaze is a training event that trains young people to engage in ministries. Unlike other training events that allows attendees to flit between different tracks, blaze provides attendees with 10 hours of intensive theoretical and practical training in a ministry of their choice. They can choose from a dozen different ministries.

Once trained we are expecting attendees to return to their church/community and use their new skills to impact the lives of their friends, family and peers. We would like pastors and churches to:

- 1. Select and support those young people within whom they see potential. Send them to blaze for training and equipping.
- 2. Provide mentorship for these young once they return. Help direct their enthusiasm, and don't let it wane.
- 3. Help create opportunities for these young people to use their new skills.

We know that being actively engage in the mission of the Church will foster spiritual growth and commitment. Thus it is imperative that young people, everybody, finds an avenue for their spiritual gifts and talents. Active members benefit the church by less problematic, more loyal and better stewards. The Youth Department believes that this represents a life on fire.

FAQ

- The minimum age is 14. This is because the training is intensive and requires significant concentration. Trainers are not there to manage behavior.
- There is no maximum age. If you will find this training beneficial to you and your ministry, then please attend.
- The price includes accommodation, meals, resources and training.
- Minors have to attend with a chaperone. We recommend a ratio of 1:8. Chaperone have to pay. We suggest that the chaperone pays the full registration fee and fully participate in the training, rather than just observing. More details about pricing are on the registration site.
- The program starts at 6 pm on Friday, and concludes on Sunday at 11:40 am.

Bible study. This training is conducted by Union College, and will focus on training participants to use a particular Bile study series. The aim is to enable young people to lead a one-on-one study which results in commitment and baptism.

Counselling. This trains people to counsel those who are going through tough situation. There is a focus on tough situations that teens experience. However, these skills are easily transferable. The course book is Josh McDowell's Handbook on Counseling Young People. The trainer is Pastor Mathew Christo, who is a trained psychologist.

Drama Ministry will be taught by Union College. The training will focus on how to use drama to share the gospel. Participants will learn to select and prepare their drama troupe. They'll earn how to engage the audience in public performances., select an prepare scripts. The aim is for young people to use drama inside and outside the church. Drama ministry is replacing Social Media Ministry.

Emergency Response, trains and prepares people to provide physical and emotional support during an emergency/natural disaster. The training is provided by ACTS World Relief and the trainer is Pastor David Canther. The aim is to have a pool of people who can assist the emergency services during a crisis, and in particular provide spiritual and emotional support to the victims, families and the emergency personnel.

Hospital Chaplaincy. There are chaplains based in virtually every hospital in Florida. We can assist them with their work. Hospital Chaplaincy training will teach you how to connect with the hospital chaplaincy department and how to conduct yourself. It will also provide essential skills so that you can competently navigate chaplain duties. We would like young people to get involved this field of work. This track is taught by Florida Hospital.

Kids Creative Ministry will help participants learn kids focused activities so that they can run a children's ministry in their community. They will be trained by Judy Smith the Director of Children & Family Ministry. The aim is for young people to start children focused outreach programs in their community.

Medical Missionaries assist the gospel by providing whole

person health solutions that are natural and simple. Using the principles outlined in our health message, they provide solutions to many common ailments and diseases. No conventional medical training is needed. We want to set up teams of medical missionaries, across the Conference, who can conduct community health programs. This training is sponsored by Sanare Life.

Preacher Training, trains a person to conduct a 7-10 day evangelistic series by customizing an established evangelistic script. The aim is for young people to return to their church and conduct this evangelistic series. We are also planning a mission trip, so that participants can preach this series in another country. Small Groups allow people to connect, make friends, and be introduced to the Gospel. Starting and maintaining a small group is what will be taught, as well as providing valuable skills needed for leading out during meetings. The material comes from the Trans-European Division, and the trainers are Pastor Marius Asaftei and Reggie Taylor. We would like every young person to be a part of a small group. We would also like to see our young people starting small groups in the high schools and colleges.

Song Writing and Composition will enable participants to share their faith and the gospel through original music which they have composed. Carmen Cruz, a singer songwriter, will lead this track. The aim is empower young people to write/compose their own music. Eventually we want to release a CD of original works. We also want to hold free open-air concerts featuring you and your music.

Creative Christian Movement is the expression of faith and the gospel through movement. This is more than signing to a sound track. It's using the whole body to gracefully and spiritually express the words and sentiments of our faith Participants will be taught how to select sounds and choreograph. This track is taught by Daniela Jean who has a thriving ministry.



Student Accommodation Needed

Eleven students from China are studying at Forest Lake Academy this school year. During the Thanksgiving and Spring breaks they would like to find families to host them, rather than travelling back to China. Staying in America also gives them further opportunity to learn about their host culture and values.

Host families should have a spare room which the student has to themselves. There should also be a private bathroom, or if shared, it can be shared with other children aged 14-18. Students prefer to stay in pairs and are happy to share a room with their fellow student. Host families will have to undergo the Shield the Vulnerable Training as well as undergo a background check. It is preferred that host families live in the Apopka area. The students will need three meals a day. Host act as parents, and should provide parental, pastoral care as well as transport to venues in the local vicinity.

The fee for hosting is \$250. The dates for hosting are: 20-29 November and 5-13 April.

Next year we'll be running the intermediate wilderness survival training, where you cannot bring a shelter. But this year's training will prepare you for next year.
