

Captain Ed's Pricing Schedule for 2013

Basic Sailing class part one

This is a two day class, with each class lasting approximately 5 hrs and will deal with the safe handling of a sailing vessel while both under power as well as sail. We will learn how to take the Bella Donna down the Merrimack River, to the ocean while under power. Once on the ocean we learn how to raise the sails and how to maneuver the boat while under sail, learning both tacking as well as Jibing procedures as well as how to hold a course.

The cost is \$300 per person.

Basic Sailing class part two

This is a two day class as well where we will work on seamanship skills as well as man over board drills. You will be expected to demonstrate the skills that you have learned in the basic sailing class part one. Upon completion of this class you will be awarded the world famous captain Ed's Coffee Mug

The cost is \$300 per person.

If you sign up for all four Basic Sailing classes the price will be \$550 per person

If you would like to join us for one of these classes to see if you would be interested in taking future classes the price for a single class will be \$200, you will have a chance to up grade to the next class for \$100.

Basic navigation

During this class we will learn how to navigate a course using both hand tools, and nautical charts, as well as GPS. We will also learn how to determine our set, drift, time and distance, over our course. This class will also last approximately 5hrs and the cost will also be \$200 per person. If you have signed up for both basic sailing one and two the price will \$150 per-person

Night time navigation

This class, will deal with sailing at night and the navigation lights on our boat plus navigation lights on both the water as well as surrounding boats, as we come up the Merrimack River at night. This class will usually start around 5pm and end around 10pm the cost is \$200 per person \$150 for those who have signed up for the previous classes.

Sail out to the Isle of Shoals or over to Rockport full day \$200 per person \$150 for those who have signed up for the Basic sailing class part one and two these trips may also be part of your basic sailing class, or basic navigation class if they work out into your class.

Family Hands on Sailing

Come out and sail as a family. Under my instruction you will motor out to the ocean with your family at the helm, raise the sails and sail along either Salisbury Beach, or Plum

Island maybe even out to the Isle of shoals if we are lucky. This will last approximately 5 plus hrs. On the weekends will cost \$400 weekdays \$350

These prices are for new clients as many of my existing clients have already bought special packages that have them sailing at a rate of \$100 per trip. Once you have signed up and paid for a five class package for \$600 you can also sail for \$100 per trip.

All classes have a mixture of different levels working on different aspects of sailing, we have some folks who purchase sailing packages who just like to come out sailing without the cost of owning a boat, they are what make Captain Ed's Sailing affordable.

If you would like to learn on your own boat the price is \$350 per day (5hrs)

If you would like a training delivery this side of Cape Ann or Portsmouth NH the price will be \$350. A training delivery to Gloucester, or Salem Ma. is \$500, to Boston \$600. Every where else is \$350 per day plus traveling expenses if they are not arranged by owner of boat. I have a delivery contract that you can read if interested in that sort of thing.
