- ❖ <u>Fellowship</u>: Report Received. Discussed interest in a Mardi Gras event next February. Kitchen needs a 2nd garbage disposal and an ice maker. Possible money can come from Penny fund. - ❖ <u>Finance & Stewardship:</u> Report Received. Annual Financial Review was performed on June 27, 2015. Insurance Policy numbers, coverage limits, anniversary dates and premium were the same as the previous year and no changes recommended. Two recommendations were approved:
 - 1. Coffee/Chocolate sales develop a weekly report of income from sales with funds deposited on a regular basis along with the offering.
