

We are excited that your student will be using an iPad as a part of their Wayzata Public Schools learning experience. We know that as a parent or guardian, you want the best learning environment for your student — one that makes learning personal and allows for creativity, collaboration, and critical thinking.

In order for the District to request an Under 13 Apple ID for your student(s) to use with the MyWay iPad Program, we are asking you to [complete this form](#). This information will be submitted to Apple and Apple will contact you via email to request permission to assign an Under 13 Apple ID to your student(s).

You will receive an email from Apple titled ***Apple ID for Students — Parent/Guardian*** which will provide you with detailed information and instructions regarding the creation of your child's Under 13 Apple ID. At that time you will be asked to do the following:

- Record the Apple temporary password
- Verify your child's information
- With your child, set the Apple ID password similar to their Active Directory password, capitalizing the first letter. See example.
 - 12ab34cd - Active Directory (student login password) example password
 - 12**A**b34cd - Apple ID example password (Apple requires one capital letter.)
- Establish Security Questions
- Verify parent information
- Read and agree to the Terms and Conditions
- Read and agree to the Parent or Guardian Consent

Wayzata Public Schools provides management and restrictions for all iPads, preventing students from accessing some apps that are typically enabled with an Apple ID. For example, Facetime, Messages and Game Center are disabled on all Wayzata student issued iPads.

It is imperative that your child know their Apple ID and password.
