Summary: Provides for the ordinary operating expenses of state government for Fiscal Year 2016-2017

HB98 (SCHOOLS/CHARTER) - Patricia Smith

POSITION: Oppose

Summary: Provides relative to local charter authorizers and Type 1B charter schools

HB167 (SCHOOLS/CHARTER) - Patricia Smith

POSITION: Oppose

Summary: Prohibits the State Bd. of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE) from authorizing certain types of charter schools under certain fiscal circumstances

HB168 (SCHOOLS/CHARTER) - Patricia Smith

POSITION: Oppose

Summary: Requires charter school teachers to meet same certification requirements as other public school teachers

HB204 (PUBLIC CONTRACT/BIDS) - Rodney Lyons, Sr

Summary: Provides an exception for Jefferson Parish from certain time limitations on submission of information with public bids

HB379 (CONSTITUTION/CONVENTION) - Franklin Foil

Summary: Provides for calling a limited constitutional convention for fiscal purposes and preparations therefor (OR INCREASE GF EX See Note)

HB382 (CONSTITUTION/CONVENTION) - Kenneth E. Havard

Summary: Provides for calling a limited constitutional convention for fiscal purposes (OR INCREASE GF EX See Note)

HB399 (SCHOOLS/ADMINISTRATORS) - J. Rogers Pope

Summary: Provides relative to requirements for local school superintendents' contracts

HB502 (SCHOOLS/CHARTER) - Patricia Smith

POSITION: Oppose

Summary: Requires the State Bd. of Elementary and Secondary Education to conduct a fiscal impact study prior to making a determination relative to a Type 2 charter school proposal (OR NO IMPACT See Note)

HB508 (FUNDS/FUNDING) - Jay Morris

Summary: (Constitutional Amendment) Establishes the Mineral Revenue Stabilization Trust Fund and provides for the deposit of mineral revenues (OR -\$200,000,000 GF RV See Note)

HB555 (SCHOOLS/FINANCE-MFP) - Gregory A. Miller

POSITION: Oppose

Summary: Provides relative to the payment of unfunded accrued liabilities of the Teachers' Retirement System of La. from minimum foundation program funds allocated to charter schools (OR INCREASE SG RV See Note)

HB616 (APPROPRIATIONS) - Cameron Henry

Summary: Appropriates funds for the expenses of the judiciary for Fiscal Year 2016-2017

HB698 (PORTS/HARBORS/TERMINALS) - Julie Stokes

Summary: Changes territorial jurisdiction of the Port of New Orleans and the Port of South Louisiana

HB716 (FUNDS/FUNDING) - Jay Morris

Summary: Establishes the Mineral Revenue Stabilization Trust Fund for the deposit of mineral revenues and provides for the dedication of mineral revenues (OR -\$200,000,000 GF RV See Note)

HB733 (CONSTITUTION/CONVENTION) - Neil Abramson

Summary: Provides for calling a limited constitutional convention for fiscal purposes and preparations therefor (EG INCREASE GF EX See Note)

HB879 (SCHOOLS/CHARTER) - Dr. Joseph Bouie

Summary: Prohibits for-profit operators of charter schools

HB1004 (SCHOOLS/CHARTER) - Kenneth E. Havard

Summary: Provides relative to assets or property acquired or used by charter schools under certain circumstances

SB78 (MALPRACTICE) - Ryan Gatti

Summary: Increases medical malpractice cap for certain child brain injuries. (gov sig) (EG NO IMPACT See Note)

SB79 (TOPS) - Blade Morrish

Summary: Provides relative to TOPS awards amounts. (gov sig) (EG SEE FISC NOTE GF EX See Note)

SB80 (POSTSECONDARY ED) - Blade Morrish

Summary: Constitutional amendment to authorize the postsecondary education management boards to establish tuition and fee amounts charged by institutions under their supervision and management. (2/3-CA13sl(A)) (EG INCREASE SG RV See Note)

SB83 (PRESCRIPTION) - Ryan Gatti

Summary: Extends period within which to file delictual actions from one to two years. (gov sig) (EG NO IMPACT See Note)

SB174 (TOPS) - Jack Donahue

POSITION: Support

Summary: Provides relative to the minimum ACT score for TOPS eligibility and TOPS award amounts. (gov sig) (EN SEE FISC NOTE GF EX See Note)

SB182 (FUNDS/FUNDING) - Rick Ward, III

Summary: Constitutional amendment to require deposit of certain mineral revenue into the Transportation Trust Fund. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))(7/1/17) (OR SEE FISC NOTE GF RV)

SB254 (EMPLOYMENT) - Jean-Paul Morrell

Summary: Provides that the Louisiana Equal Pay Act be applicable to men and private employers and requires government contractors to verify equal pay practices. (8/1/16)

SB269 (EMPLOYMENT) - Karen Carter Peterson

POSITION: Oppose

Summary: Provides for an increase in the state minimum wage. (2/3-CA7s2.1)(8/1/16) (EG +\$247,982 EX See Note)

SB327 (CIVIL PROCEDURE) - Jay Luneau

Summary: Provides for Louisiana False Claims Act. (8/1/16) (EG SEE FISC NOTE SD EX See Note)

SB329 (TOPS) - Dan Claitor

Summary: Increases the minimum GPA required for the Performance and Honors Awards. (gov sig) (EG DECREASE GF EX See Note)

SB347 (EMPLOYMENT) - Troy Carter

POSITION: Oppose

Summary: Repeals restrictions which bar local governmental subdivisions from enacting local labor ordinances which establish a minimum wage and a minimum number of vacation and sick leave days. (8/1/16)

SB378 (TAX/LOCAL) - Danny Martiny

Summary: Provides relative to the hotel occupancy tax in Jefferson Parish. (8/1/16)

SB470 (TOPS) - Blade Morrish

Summary: Provides relative to reduction of TOPS award amounts or the number of TOPS recipients in the event of insufficient funding. (gov sig) (RE SEE FISC NOTE GF EX See Note)
