The 2014-2015 school year at Ben Franklin Academy was a memorable one for many reasons. From an academic perspective, Ben Franklin Academy achieved its goal of offering an exceptional college preparatory education for each of its students with great success. The thirty-four seniors in the class of 2015 (pictured on the front cover) were awarded more than \$2.6 million in

scholarships, including 79% who qualified for the Hope Scholarship. In addition, more than 76% of the graduating seniors were admitted into their first choice of colleges which are among the finest and most challenging schools of higher education in the country. We wish our graduates continued success as they move into the next exciting chapter in their lives.

Faculty and parents worked together during the 2014-2015 school year to provide the support that all our students in grades 9-12 need to be successful. We are grateful to our Trustees and Overseers for their continued leadership and help in achieving goals outlined in the school's Strategic Plan.

While the purpose of this report is to acknowledge and give thanks for the many contributions received during the past academic year, we would be remiss if we did not also acknowledge the recent passing of two distinct contributors to Ben Franklin Academy.

Dr. Wood Smethurst, Co-Founder of the school, and Dr. C. Michael York, former Board Chairman, were two of Ben Franklin Academy's dedicated leaders. Our community remains deeply saddened by the loss of these two leaders.

Dr. Martha Burdette, Dr. Smethurst's co-founding partner, was appointed Head of School by the Board of Trustees at the end of June. We look forward to her leadership during the 2015-2016 school year and beyond with both excitement and pride. Next year, Ben Franklin Academy will conclude the final step toward reaccreditation with the SACS/SAIS Visit in the fall. This process is always a wonderful time to evaluate both the strengths and opportunities for improvement within the school and will help launch BFA to the next level of private, secondary school education.

Before highlighting the many accomplishments from the 2014-2015 academic year, I would like to thank you for your support as our community remembers, honors, and celebrates the life of Dr. Wood Smethurst, my co-founding partner. It is truly a blessing that we had him for as long as we did, and I am grateful for all that he gave both to me, as my mentor, and to our students. He recognized their talents, and he helped each student find success in learning. He believed that the highest calling one could have is to be a teacher, and he lived in a way that demonstrated his passion for education, Mastery Learning, and a love for all of God's children. The Smethurst Family has generously asked that all donations made in memory of Dr. Smethurst go to the Wood Smethurst Scholarship Fund to help students who otherwise could not attend our school.



As we dedicate this Annual Report to Dr. Smethurst, we recognize how integral his role was in the success of the 2014-2015 academic school year. It was one of the school's strongest years to date, thanks to our outstanding Faculty and Staff. A few highlights include:

- We continued 2013-2014's trend of strong enrollment, with 134 in the High School Program and 153 in the Clinic Program. Over 50% of students chose the Longer Day Option, continuing a three-year trend of growth in this area.
- Our sports teams had outstanding seasons. The Cross Country team had a particularly noteworthy season and participated in eight meets. Over the course of these meets, every runner improved his/her personal record. At BFA we like to celebrate these individual victories, which highlight personal growth both in and out of the classroom.
- The Parent Committee provided strong support this year, hosting student lunches, parent socials, and a graduation party for the seniors and their parents. We believe that the success of our Annual Fund efforts can be attributed, in part, to their dedicated efforts.
- Our Alumni Committee planned its inaugural reunion event at The Luminary Restaurant for all BFA alumni and their parents. We had a great turnout, which included attendees from a broad range of classes.

I appreciate the efforts of the Trustees, Overseers, Faculty, Staff, parents, students, and friends who made it possible for our school to continue to prosper and address the unique needs of our students – even during times of loss and leadership transitions. I look forward to the next phase of our work together, and I am honored by the Trustee's decision to appoint me Head of School.

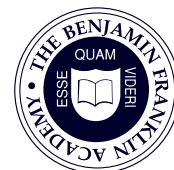
