9:00am Services	This service will be nearly two hours long and will include a variety of Hebrew and English prayers and readings.	Multiple aliyot (sections) of Torah will be chanted by TBC members.	Familiar classic High Holy Days music and contemporary settings with keyboard accompaniment, enriched by our professional choir.	The prayers and music in this service will make it feel more formal than our regular Shabbat services. This service is meant for adults and families who enjoy the classic High Holy Day prayer experience.
12:00pm Services	This service will last for about an hour and fifteen minutes. It will include the major prayers of the morning service as well as creative, English readings.	We will invite all children present to join us on the bimah as Cantor Sobel chants one aliyah (section) from the Torah.	Less formal contemporary musical settings with guitar and bass accompaniment in addition to traditional favorites.	Anyone who enjoys the participatory feeling of our TBC Shabbat services will feel comfortable at this service. Adults and families who like that more informal style should come to this service.
