How we support our network

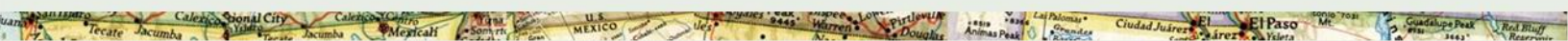
- **We provide high-impact services** including research, coaching and access to practical and timely tools for organization building;

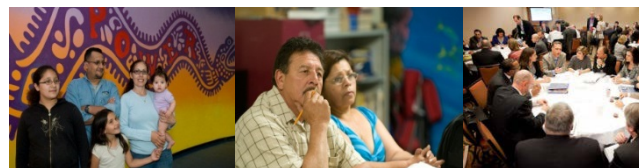
