OUT AND ABOUT SAFETY

INCLUDING PERSONAL BOUNDARIES

Family outings are great fun and create memories that last a lifetime. As a parent we know that safety is paramount when our children are out and about. Reviewing your children's radKIDS plans for out and about safety can never hurt and it will give you both piece-of-mind as they go through the lessons learned in their radKIDS classes. We encourage you to support your review and guidance as your child makes their plans within the context and support of the 3 rules all radKIDS know:

1. No one has the right to hurt me because I am special!
2. I don't have the right to hurt anyone else, including myself, unless they try to hurt me and then I stop them!
3. If anyone tries to hurt me, trick me, or make me feel bad inside, it's not my fault -- So I can tell!

Out and About

What's your **radKIDS Plan** when there are lots of people around like malls, stores, sporting events, carnivals or fairs? (Sight-Sound-Distance).

What's your radKIDS Plan IF... you get lost or loose your safety partner? Who can you go to for help?

What's your radKIDS Plan IF... some you don't know approaches you in a car?

What IF they ask you for directions or want you to get into their car?

What's your radKIDS Plan IF... somebody you don't know comes up to you on the playground or asks to play a game with you?

What's your radKIDS Plan IF... someone tries to trick you, grab you or hurt you?

Personal Boundaries

What's your radKIDS Plan IF... anyone touches you in a way you don't want to be touched?

What IF a person touches you and then asks you to keep it a secret or tells you something bad will happen to you or someone you love if you tell?

Review your radKIDS Family Manual and the definitions of touch-Good, Bad, Unwanted. The we suggest you and/or your child review **Sam Secret** which is also found in your radKIDS Family Manual as a beginning to summer vacation and at the start of school (at the very least) and any other time where your child might need to be reminded of the three radKIDS rules that every radKIDS knows.
