3. Please enter in the information requested (i.e. full name, login name, password, phone number, email, street address, etc.)
4. A login request will be sent to the Web master and it will be processed in the order that it was received. A confirmation e-mail will be sent to you and then you may login to the Web site as you please.

Residents' Directory and Broadcast Email

Colonial Heritage has two features that are used for regular communication. We have a Residents' Directory and we maintain a Broadcast Email list that is used to send information to the residents. Homeowner Identification Cards

All homeowners in good standing are eligible for a Colonial Heritage ID. This ID will function as a HOA member card for verification of homeowner identification and verification of Colonial Heritage homeowner account privileges. In addition to the identification, the card has electronic key capabilities for access to certain CH HOA amenities.

Outdoor Pool: Each photo ID/electronic key will access the outdoor pool gate during the seasonal scheduled operating hours.

Athletic Club: Each photo ID/electronic key will allow access into the Athletic Club facility. To schedule a facility walk-through or equipment orientation please contact our Fitness Director for more information, 757-645-2029.

Woodshop: Completion of the woodshop equipment safety training, presented by a woodshop trainer and a signed woodshop waiver form on file with the HOA office is required prior to woodshop access activation. Access to the woodshop is during regular clubhouse hours. Electronic access is located on the interior door.

Please be sure to clean up after yourself or your Woodshop privileges will be revoked.

Only one Photo ID/electronic key per person will be issued at any time, at the expense of the HOA. Loss or damage to the Photo ID/electronic key shall require the **owner to purchase a replacement key, for a cost of \$10.00, at the owners' expense. Lost, stolen or deactivated cards must be reported immediately to the HOA staff.

When you are using the computers in the Clubhouse Library, please protect your security by remembering to log out and/or sign out of everything, do not just close the site. In addition, you should also clear 'internet history' under 'tools' so that no one can go back to the sites and view any of your personal information.

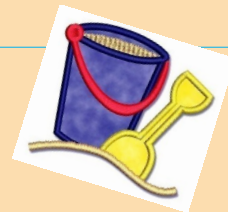

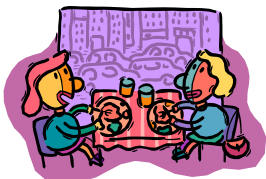
The next Towne Diners gathering will be July 9, 2015.

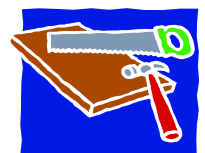

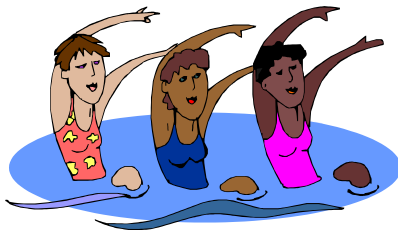
