

Youth Director

Job Description

Summary: As a spiritual mentor for the youth of Grace Covenant Presbyterian Church (GCPC), the Youth Director should strive to set the example of Christ; and, seek to live into that example through compassion, friendship, direction, and leadership that fosters faith in, and love for, God.

Departmental: This position shall report to the head of staff of GCPC; Senior Pastor.

Qualifications:

- Enthusiastic leader
- Ability to work with and direct teams that may include church leaders or other adult volunteers.
- Knowledgeable and practiced in current communication trends and social media including, but not limited to, SMS, Facebook (and similar), Instagram, Face Chat, multi-media, and e-mail.
- Education and/or experience as educator, mentor, or other leader of children and young adults (ages 4 – 18).
- Candidate must submit to security background check.

Key Responsibilities:

- Focus on building and growing the Youth Ministries of the GCPC.
- Work with adult youth volunteers to organize and/or lead weekly youth meetings.
- Availability to participate in the individual activities of the youth (sporting events, school lunches, dance recitals, hospital visits, etc.) to forge a bond and friendship with them.
- Maintain positive and open communication with youth, parents, and other youth leader volunteers via a variety of methods including social media such as blogs, texts, Facebook, and the like.
- Attend leadership and development seminars, workshops, and other training as required and appropriate.
- Other duties as assigned by senior pastor and/or Session and its committees

Salary:

- \$12,000 - \$16,000 annually
- Part time position of 15 - 20 hours per week. (\$16 per hour)
- 10 days of non-paid vacation annually
