


NDIS Evaluation

The National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) is a new way of providing support to people with disability in Australia. To find out how the NDIS trial is going, an independent Evaluation team has been set up. The team is led by the National Institute of Labour Studies (NILS) at Flinders University. The Evaluation is funded by the Australian Government Department of Social Services (DSS).

The evaluation will involve a range of studies with different groups of people. In this study we want to hear from a small number of people with a disability who have joined the NDIS. We would also like to hear from their families and carers.

We would like to speak with you twice - once in 2014 and again in 2015. We would like to speak with you about how well the NDIS trial is working for you. We want to know how the NDIS trial has affected your life.

The interview will take around one hour and we can do it at a place and time that is best for you. You can also choose how to do the interview in a way that best suits you - in person, by phone, or by Skype. You will be given \$50 for taking part in the interview in 2014 and another \$50 for taking part in the interview in 2015.

Important things to know about the interviews:

- The information you give will only be used for this evaluation
- We will keep everything you tell us private. Your name will not be in any of the reports.
- Taking part is your choice. It will not affect the support you receive.
- You can stop the interview at any time. You can also choose not to answer any questions you do not want to.
