A Perspective on the Holy Lands

The Rev. Walter F. Taylor, Jr. in January 2015 led his sixth traveling seminar to Israel and Palestine, which included discussions with Muslims, an Israeli Jewish West Bank settler, and Bishop Munib Younan of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Jordan and the Holy Land. This experience, along with the semester he lived and taught in Egypt and his study of the cultural anthropology of the Mediterranean world, will be the focus of his presentation.

Previously he was a parish pastor in Lincoln, Nebraska, and has been a visiting professor at the University of Heidelberg, Germany, and the Evangelical Theological Seminary in Cairo, Egypt. He has published 150 books, articles, chapters, reviews, and audio-visual materials, including his "Paul, Apostle to the Nations: An Introduction" (2012).
