Entries will be uploaded to the Air Pollution Control Division's Facebook page, <https://www.facebook.com/cdphe.apcd>. Designs may be voted on from November 30 to December 11, 2015, and the winner will be selected based on Facebook "likes" and an independent panel.

The tote bags will also be distributed to new mothers located throughout the state of Colorado during National Lead Poisoning Prevention Week in 2016.
