Myers Learning – Creative Coding – Scratch Lab

Participants in Scratch Lab learn to code by creating their own video games, animated stories, and interactive art. They build their projects in Scratch, an MIT-developed computer programming language for children. The class is social, hands-on, artistic, and fun -- drawing a nearly even mix of boys and girls. The class meets in the library where three teachers provide inspiration and support, as students experiment, tinker, and build. Between weekly classes, students are able to develop Scratch projects at home, publish their work online, and introduce Scratch to siblings, parents, and friends. Come explore STEM through Art - EUREKUS is an exciting STEAM enrichment program developed and taught by nationally acclaimed artists and NASA consultants, Tyler and Monica Aiello. During our first session at University Park, students will have a blast exploring engineering with a host of cool art and Maker-based projects. Imaginations will be charged during *Simply Machines*, an action-packed program investigating simple and complex machines through building, tinker-time and collaborative work. The program will progress from creative projects that focus on the 6 simple machines to the development of more complex contraptions paired with fun science experiments. Learners engage in innovative problem-solving while also exploring the role of engineering in the context of history, human invention and daily life. Throughout, students gain foundations in classical mechanics, the design process and scientific principles while working hand-on with mentoring teaching artists. *Projects include designing kinetic contraptions, working puppetry, moveable sculpture, air-powered vehicles, NASA Maker programs, rockets and more!*
