- 3. During professional development each grade level will meet with the entire support staff to begin creating 3 well balanced classrooms**
- 4. Staff will create 3 balanced classrooms and submit to Mr. Varveris before the end of the year**
- 5. Mr. Varveris will place teachers names on class lists after the roster is made – this is to ensure our ability to create 3 well balanced classrooms**
- 6. Parents will be informed through our newsletter and posted on door 3 in early/mid July**
